Before downloading and utilizing the SWTS data, please read and adhere to the following guidelines:

1. Data Citation

When using the SWTS data for research, reports, or any other purposes, please ensure proper attribution. Cite the data as follows:

2. Free Download and Liability

3. Caution and Reference to Technical Notes

Exercise caution when using the data. Before drawing conclusions from your analysis, it is essential to refer to our technical notes within the SWTS report (**APPENDIX 1**). These notes provide critical insights into the methodology of data collection and sampling selection.

4. Data Files

The SWTS dataset consists of five different STATA files, each corresponding to different respondent categories:

- i. In-school youth
- ii. Youth in tertiary education
- iii. Youth seeking employment
- iv. Youth currently employed
- v. Employers

Each category employs distinct methodologies and sample selection criteria. For detailed explanations, please consult **Appendix 1** in SWTS report.
